

A note from our General Manager:

The National Day for Truth and Reconciliation is September 30th. Last year, 2021 represented the first year it was recognized as a Federal Statutory public holiday. To date, it has not yet been recognized by all provinces and territories as a provincial public holiday, leaving organizations in such provinces, like your Credit Union, to decide for themselves how to recognize this important day. In 2021, the Credit Union opted to close our doors that day, and staff completed the 4 Seasons of Reconciliation course to aid in our understanding of our own history. It is important to your Board of Directors that we support this day, via reflection and commemoration, as we recognize that only by understanding the impact of our mutual history, can we move forward together in a meaningful way.

May we all make use of that day to remind ourselves from where we all came and seek understanding in moving into the future.
